Rules & Guidelines

- Booths will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Booths will be assigned according to the date a paid application is received. Paid booth rental is non-refundable due to any reason, including inclement weather. Rental funds will only be refunded if application is denied.
- The event will start at 7 a.m. and conclude at 5 p.m. each day - rain or shine. Vendors must keep booths open during show hours. Any signs of early packing by vendors can make the remaining customers uneasy and tends to end last-minute shopping.
- Booth set up will be Wednesday, Sept. 30, from noon to 8 p.m. Vendors will also have an opportunity to set up and restock from 5 to 7 p.m. each evening prior to the next day’s event.
- Booths need to be set up by 6:45 a.m. each day. Vehicles must be moved to the parking area by 6:30 a.m.
- Tents, tables and chairs are not furnished. Please bring your own. Vendors are also responsible for bringing their own staging items.
- The Hwy. 79-63 Junk Hunt Hub does not guarantee sales.
- Vendors are solely responsible for complying with Hwy. 79-63 Junk Hunt Hub regulations, and city and state tax regulations.
- The Hwy. 79-63 Junk Hunt Hub reserves the right to regulate and/or refuse any items it deems improper or offensive.
- Vendors grant permission to promoter to use images of vendor booths/items for any purpose in promoting the event. The promoter may crop, alter or modify/combine such images with other images, text and graphics without notifying vendor.
